Master of Leadership and Change Management (MLCM) - NQF Level 9

The programme has been specifically designed to prepare participants to meet the challenges of the ever-changing organisational context globally, whilst incorporating specific local needs and solutions. The programme is aligned with the requirements of the NUST curriculum Framework and the National Qualifications Framework (NQF).

Admission Requirements:

- A four-year Bachelor degree or an equivalent qualification at NQF level 8, which includes a component of supervised research, or a graduate degree with a research component.
- Three years working experience in a managerial capacity.
- A letter motivating why you wish to enrol for the programme.
- Proficiency in English language should be demonstrated at the appropriate level by either the undergraduate degree that was completed in the medium of English; successful completion of an International English Language testing System (IELTS) at minimum band 7 or through written assessments under controlled conditions.

Master of Business Administration (MBA) - NQF Level 9

This programme aims at developing a critical awareness and an integrated understanding of organisational management amongst students, as well as their ability to take on leadership and management roles in public, private and non-profit organisations.

Admission requirements:

- A four-year Bachelor degree or an equivalent qualification at NQF level 8, which includes a component of supervised research, or a recognised graduate degree with a research component.
- Two years business and managerial experience.
- Be employed or self-employed at managerial level for at least two years.
- Provide a motivational letter providing reasons for wishing to enrol for the programme.
- Proficiency in English language should be demonstrated at the appropriate level by either the undergraduate degree that was completed in the medium of English; successful completion of an International English Language testing System (IELTS) at minimum band 7 or through written assessments under controlled conditions.

Note: Programme lectures are offered online, on block release twice a month. Applicants for both programmes may be required to write an admission test or take part in an interview.
